

Shortens long words. *Abbreviation*
Front part of a word that changes it's meaning. *Prefix*

Provides place and nutrients for plants to grow. *Soil*
Makes writing and reading easier. *Punctuation*
A picture that represents a word. *Symbol*
Used to delay payment. *Credit*
