What's Next?

An adjacent sentence describes each picture. The instructor covers the entire page with a piece of paper, and uses another paper to cover the current sentence. Students are instructed to guess the next word in each sentence, beginning with the first. Each student gets one guess per turn. Points or praise may be given for correct guesses. If the word is not guessed after each student takes two turns, the instructor reveals the word and goes to the next word. Clues are sometimes necessary for difficult words.

Noncompetitive rules: Students work together to try to guess the words before time runs out.



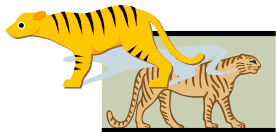
The girl is reading a book.



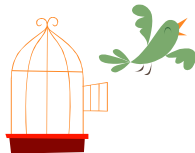
The man is raking leaves.



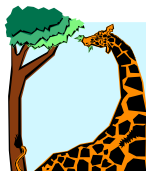
Her eyes are closed.
